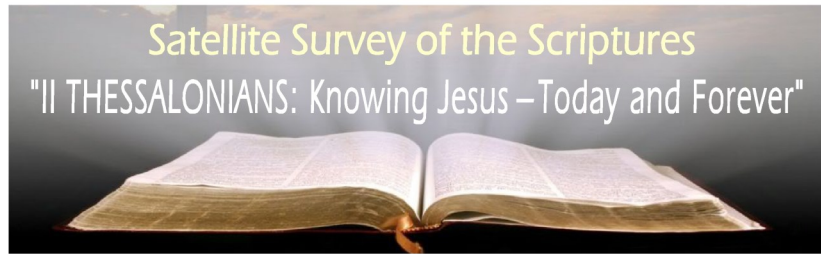

When Apostle Paul wrote this second letter to the Church of the Thessalonians, he must have sensed that some of Jesus' followers were being influenced by people who promoted false teaching. Also, it appears that some of them might have been so focused on Jesus' return that they quit working and watched for Him to come back at any time.

The letter tells us how believers should live and emphasizes the hope we have in Jesus Christ, as well as warns unbelievers of their horrible future without Him. The conclusion is to get along with each other and make the best use of our days for God's honor.

 - c. The "man of lawlessness" will be limited until the Holy Spirit is removed.
 - d. Watch out for false religions.
