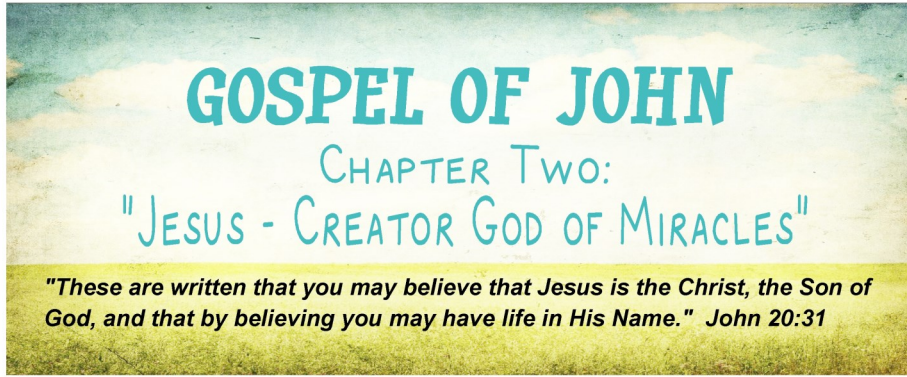

MESSAGE NOTES

Based on whatever Bible scholar we read, the number of miracles on record performed by Jesus will vary, and we know that much of His ministry goes beyond the four Gospels (see John 21:25).

The Gospel of John records fewer miracles than the other Gospels, but sufficient to support his declaration that Jesus is God in a human body. John records the first one when Jesus turned water into wine at the wedding in Cana of Galilee.

Jesus' power to do miracles is evidence of His deity, and we are grateful for the recorded stories. The greatest miracle is that He loves us, gave His life to cancel the penalty for our sin, and lives today as our Savior Who will take us to be with Him forever. No other person can claim this accomplishment.

There are principles from John 2 that we need to follow:

1. Jesus should be invited to every wedding.
2. We should not presume to know God's timing.

3. The miraculous sign was for a few people who would believe – not yet for the masses.
4. Followers of Jesus make up the "Father's House" today.
5. We should not demand a miraculous sign in order to believe.

Ponder:

How can I use this chapter of Jesus' life to help someone see that Jesus is Creator God?
