

## MESSAGE NOTES

The Gospel of John is repetitive in declaring that Jesus is God. It does not explain how Father, Son and Spirit can be One Person – no human explanation is adequate. All Three are found in the entire Bible.

The Old Testament declares worship of one God: "Hear, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord is one! And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might" (Deuteronomy 6:4-5).

The New Testament focuses on Jesus Who reveals in a perfect human body what God is like and the Spirit Who is God's personal Presence in each believer. "What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we beheld and our hands handled, concerning the Word of Life – and the life was manifested, and we have seen and bear witness and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was manifested to us . . ." (I John 1:1-2).

Father, Son and Spirit are present when Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist (Matthew 3:16-17). When a human meets Jesus, and believes that He is God, their life is changed forever. This is the message of John 3:16-17 and Romans 10:9-10.
