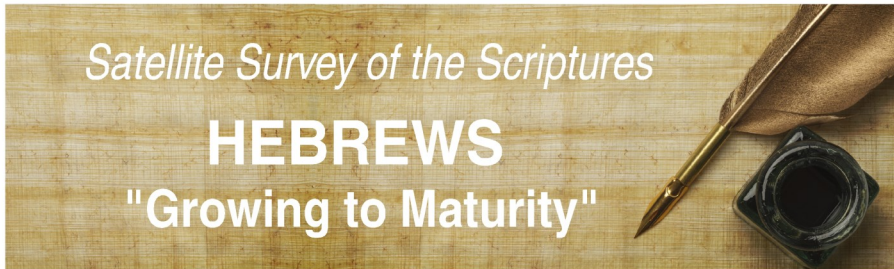

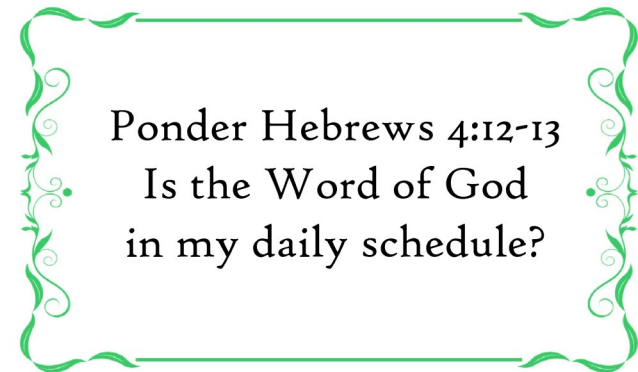


By the time Hebrews was written (perhaps late 60's), it was becoming obvious that the Church was gaining momentum and the Synagogues were in decline. This provoked persecution from the Jews, which caused some Jewish followers of Jesus to return their focus to the law.

Judaism as a system was both political and religious – think about Israel under the leadership of King David. Losing both their land and the temple to Roman dominance caused them to focus on their roots and survival. Jewish Christians had to decide whether to follow the Rabbis of Old Testament teaching or to follow the developing Scriptures of the New Testament. Grace and Law were in ongoing conflict in the minds of many.
