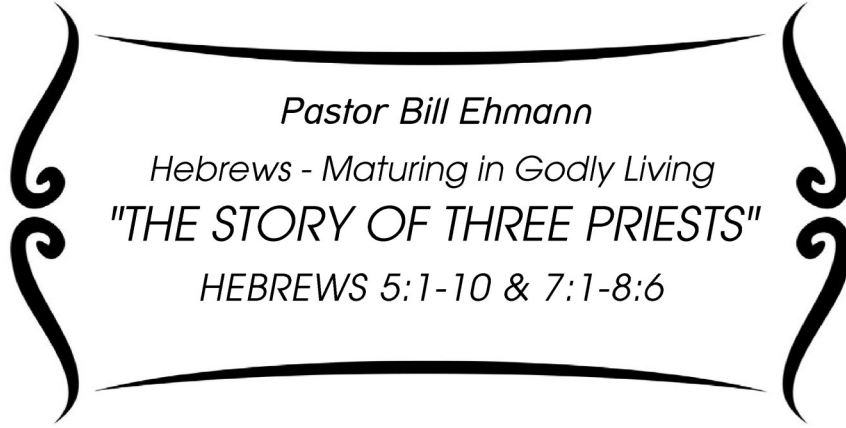


MESSAGE NOTES

The office of “priest” is mentioned throughout the Bible. It is important to understand the various ways the title is used – especially when considering that Jesus is called “our High Priest.”

Most of the Old Testament is focused on the Nation Israel. Their system of worship centered at the Tabernacle, later the Temple. The priests were from the family of Levi and began with Aaron.

Before the worship system was outlined in Exodus and Leviticus, a priest called Melchizedek met with Israel’s human father, Abraham, after he had rescued his nephew, Lot, from enemy kidnapping. This priest is mentioned in

Genesis 14, prophetically in Psalm 104 and finally explained in Hebrews.
