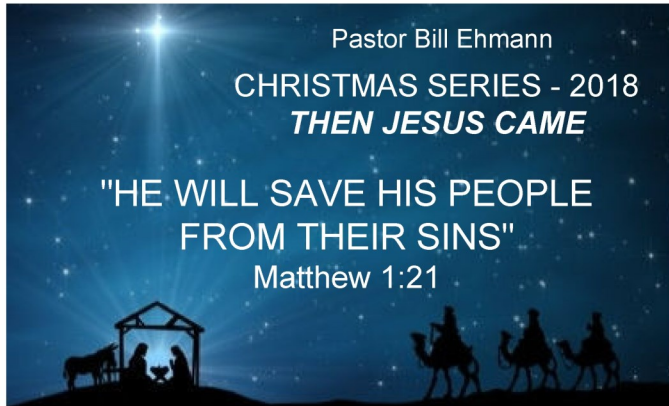


# Message Notes

Creator God wants to dwell with humans. This is evident throughout the Bible. Consider "Immanuel – God with us." God likes to rescue humans who are in trouble; that includes each of us. Sin is our impossible issue. The Holy God cannot have fellowship with sinful humans.

Then Jesus came. Joseph was told (Matthew 1:21) that "Jesus will save His people from their sins." That was the best news since Adam and Eve turned away from Creator God and trusted the counterfeit god, Satan.

Definition of sin: Human arrogance challenging Creator God's authority.

1. Sin presented itself in the Garden of Eden.
2. Sin became the pattern of human life throughout the centuries.

3. Sin has a Remedy promised in the Old Testament and announced by the angel to Joseph in Matthew 1:21.
4. Sin and Satan were defeated when Jesus died on the cross.
5. The resurrection of Jesus from the dead demonstrates His power over sin and His ability to connect humans to Creator God.

*Jesus came to save you from your sin. He has done His part. Have you accepted His Gift of Salvation? Ephesians 2:8-9 and Romans 10:9-10 are yours to believe and possess.*
