

From the last Sunday of August through the end of November, we camped in Hebrews 11, often called the "faith chapter." We return today to Hebrews following the Christmas series, "Then Jesus Came."

- Faith is based on the character of God with confidence that God cannot lie. It is taking God at His Word. Faith is a gift from God.

- 2. Abel lived by faith without the benefit of example. 11:4
- 3. Enoch lived by faith "he pleased God." 11:5-6
- 4. Noah lived by faith he had "holy fear." 11:7
- 5. Abraham lived by faith he trusted without details.

- 6. Isaac lived by faith he anticipated a good future. 11:20
- 7. Jacob lived by faith he bargained and believed. 11:21
