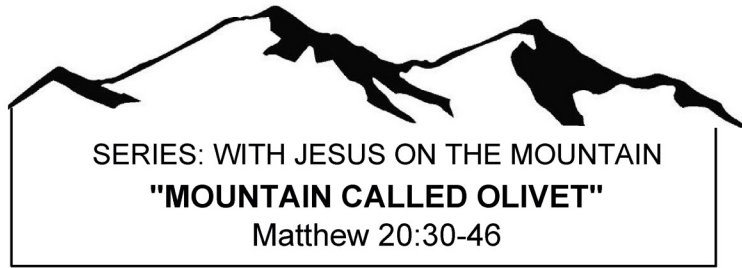


# Message Notes

Our times in recent weeks with Jesus on the mountains have given us insight into Jesus' teaching, handling of testing and a glance into the heavenly environment. Today we walk with Him through the part of the journey that leads eventually to His rejection and death.

Two events precede the time on the Mount of Olives: the final Passover Celebration and the first Lord's Supper or Communion as we often call it today.

1. The Final Passover Meal                      Matthew 26:17-25
2. The First Lord's Supper                      Matthew 26:26-29

Following these events, Jesus moved with His friends to the Mount of Olives.

1. On the Mount of Olives                      Matthew 26:30-49

- a. The Hymn
- b. The Lonely Shepherd
- c. The attempt at loyalty by Jesus' friends
- d. The Submissive Savior
- e. The sleepy friends
- f. The betrayer's kiss

## 2. Lessons to Ponder

- a. Speak less – listen more; words are easy – what counts is follow-through.
- b. Submission to God can be a lonely experience, but obedience always pays dividends.
- c. It is a great honor to God when we are found faithful.
