"LIFE WITH CHRIST DOES NOT JUST HAPPEN — IT IS PLANNED"


Philippians 1:12-19

From the time that Paul met Jesus on the road to Damascus to the end of his life, he believed that whatever experiences came to him were from God. His priority was to tell Jesus' Story – in his words, "advance the Gospel." As he writes from prison, he is confident that it is where he was supposed to be at the time.

Philippians was written to committed followers of Jesus. The principles are for people who share Paul's commitment to Him. To apply these ideas to an unbeliever's life would not make sense. The outlook of a Christian is different from a person who does not know Christ.
