Daniel Chapter Four

If we enjoy giving someone bad news, even if we feel they deserve it, we should evaluate our attitude and priorities.

If we fail to deliver bad news, when it is our responsibility to do so, we are not living up to our assignment.

Daniel was consistent in both areas, and God honored his faithfulness. He is an excellent mentor.
