**Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? Run in such a way as to get the prize.**

1 Cor 9:24

Jesus teaches us about the kingdom of Heaven with the parable of a man who went on a long journey. He entrusted his property to three of his servants according to their ability. When he returned a long time later, he settled the accounts with them. What they had done while he was gone resulted in an appropriate response.

Later, the Apostle Paul reminds us that we have been entrusted with the work of Christ. He states that his life means nothing unless he does the work assigned to him. The work assigned to Paul and to all believers is to testify to the Gospel of Christ.

These two accounts are not unrelated — Jesus has gone on a journey and will one day return to settle up accounts.
