

Colossians: Christ in Us, Our Hope and Glory

"One Man's Ministry"

Colossians 1:24 – 2:5

This is our fifth message from the Book of Colossians. The main theme is The Supremacy of Christ.

Last week we heard Paul summarize that theme for us. Jesus is Creator, King, and Author of a New Creation: The Church.

This week we read Paul's response to that theme, as he talks about his personal ministry.

## 1. A Ministry of Suffering ( 1:24)

Three things are said about the sufferings of Paul

- They are for the sake of others
- They are identified with Christ
- They are a source of joy

## 2. A Ministry of Preaching (1:25-29)

- Appointed by God
- His Message
- His Method
- His Purpose

## 3. A Ministry of Intercession ( 2:1-5)

- His concern for them
- His goal is that they be encouraged
- He wants them to know Christ deeply
- He warns them about false teaching

### Lodging

All of the hotel-style rooms and meeting rooms are located in the Riverfront Lodge. Many have a view of the beautiful Molalla River. Each room has individual heating and air conditioning. Most rooms will house 3-4 ladies per room, but we do have some single and double occupancy availability. We also have a few 6-person rooms. Each room is equipped with a private restroom.

### Cost

A limited number of single rooms is available for \$130. Double occupancy is available for \$105 per person. For 3-4 in a room, the cost is \$90. Thanks to our Silent Auction, we are able to charge less than half the cost! Rooms with more than two women may require sharing a queen bed or using a top bunk. The cost covers lodging and four meals (three on Saturday, one on Sunday). Dinner on Friday is not included, so please make your own arrangements.

### Registration

Registration begins March 1st and ends March 29th. A deposit of \$45 is due at registration to hold your spot. Full payment is due by March 29th. No refunds can be given after March 29th. Online registration is available starting on March 1st (full payment only online).
