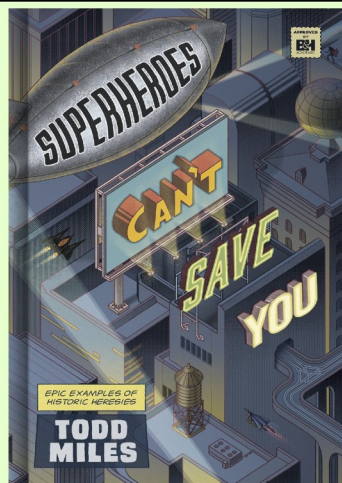

Lodging

Cost

The cost covers lodging and four meals (three on Saturday, one on Sunday). Dinner on Friday is not included, so please make your own arrangements.

Registration

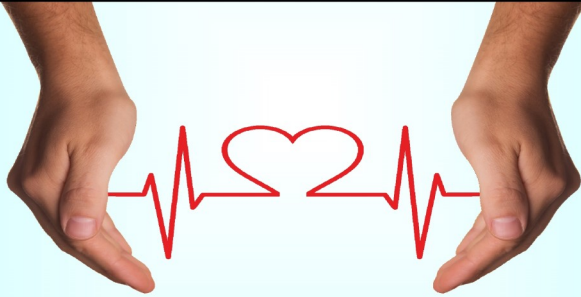
