"Superheroes Can't Save You" Epic Examples of Historic Heresies




by Dr. Todd Miles, Professor of Theology and Director of the Master of Theology Program at Western Seminary, Portland, OR



COMPASSION CLINIC

Compassion Clinic (Medical, Dental, Chiropractic, Optometrist)

A New Outreach Ministry Led by Young Adults and Youth

Wood Village Baptist Church, in partnership with Compassion Connect, Smith Memorial Presbyterian Church, and Comunidad de Gracia, will be hosting free quarterly clinics on campus beginning April 18, 2020. The clinics are offered for four hours on a Saturday, and are offered on a first-come, first-served basis. The services offered are typically dental, medical, chiropractic, optometry, social services and even haircuts.
