September 27, 2020 - Pastor Tom Miles 1 Peter: "Hope in the Midst of Suffering"

""Christ - The Foundation of Our Hope" 1 Peter 1:3-12

1 Peter was written to encourage Christian churches facing persecution and trials. His introduction reminded his readers that they were a new family "chosen" by God's Grace for a purpose. As "aliens and strangers" in a hostile land, they were to be "ambassadors" of Christ and witnesses to the Gospel.

In this passage, Peter prepares his readers for the responsibilities they have as ambassadors and the suffering they will experience. He does so by reminding them of the hope they have in Christ and His enduring work.
