The "What" of Worship?

- 1. Worship is a whole person response to the truth of who God is and the things that He has done.
 - a. Individually and corporately
 - b. Comprised of both words and actions
- 2. Two ideas in Scripture that we translate as "worship"
 - a. To bow down
 - b. To work / serve / sacrifice
- 3. We worship in spirit and in truth
 - a. Empowered by the Spirit
 - b. Blending the heart (emotion) and the mind (intellect)

The "Why" of Worship

- 1. Because He is worthy
- 2. Because we were made to worship
