Recapping Last Week's Message

- · Shepherding leaders are first and foremost servant followers
- YHWH warns and holds His shepherds to account, that they tend well to YHWH's sheep.

Our Commission: God has commissioned his church to make disciples not simply converts. And they must be taught to obey everything He has commanded. He is with us as we carry out this mission. (Today's "Reading" from Matthew 28:16-20)

Elders are required: God requires and appoints Elders to follow Him, and to shepherd and oversee His local churches and flocks in the carrying out of that commission for the church. (Acts 15, Acts 14:23, 1 Peter 5, Titus 1:5-9, 1 Timothy 3:1-7).

Elders emerge from prior testing. But what tests?: God has provided life testing as a proving ground to qualify those his Spirit will appoint as elders. Their character is not wishful or aspiring. There is to be no guesswork. (Titus 1:5-9, 1 Timothy 3:1-7)

So, what ARE their responsibilities? (1 Peter 5:1-4, Acts 20:28-31)
