On head coverings (1 Cor 11:2-16):

We know it's NOT about:

- All men and women- it's about marriage.
- Approving of any domineering.
- Showing greater authority or honor toward one group over another.

We know it IS about:

- God being honored through our worship and our entire lives.
- People being respected in our gatherings and lives.
- Covenant relationships impacting every aspect of life.

All Jesus followers should hold to his ways and seek to honor him in everything. (11:17)

All factions in the Church dishonor Christ. (1 Cor 3:1-4)

Christ's redemptive work is immensely significant, so the remembrance at communion is also significant for Christians. (11:17-34)

Communion is the symbol of unity with each other and Christ. (11:23-26)
Divisions in communion egregiously dishonor Christ and his sacrifice.

No one should participate in communion casually. (11:27-34)

In Christ, we are given much, so we should protect, care for, love, and build up His Church even at our own expense and effort.
