Saturday, June 20 | 11am-1pm | Fellowship Hall

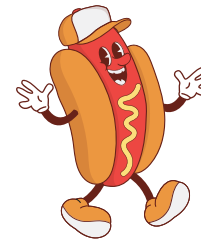
